


Yellow Rose



For this pattern, you will shave or carve out each small section of the pumpkin area by area. Don't try to carve out all the light gray sections at once, or the design will break when you try to shave out other areas! Start with the sections numbered 1, and proceed with carving and shading in numbered order.

Hint: This design is much easier to carve on a larger pumpkin! A sturdy U-shaped wood gouge is the perfect tool to shave layers out of the pumpkin's thick shell. Please note that this design has a lot of thinly cut areas, so the pumpkin will start to deteriorate more quickly than a typical Jack o'lantern face. Wait to carve this the day you want to show it off if you really want to impress your friends!
